

LED Lenser - M14 /

PART 1

Jakkals Jag

Welcome to the new world in a **BIG WAY**, jakkals jag met n LED Lenser M14. Far ahead of its time or haven't you heard of it? I just finished a good year and bought all my jakkals jag buddies a M14 as a Christmas gift, the rifle mounts are R15-00 each (you need 4) and the torch is R699-00 at CUM.

The torch is simply f%^\$@!(amazing – it is worlds ahead of Maglites, Sure fires, amazing technology, made in Germany. Other torches I used seem like toys compared to this M14.

Torch comes with a belt clip and 4 batteries.

DON'T LOOK AT IT AND SAY "AG MAN THAT'S A TOY!"

Well, I am not going to spin crap here this is as it is, the light has various settings from spot, flood, SOS, flash, self defence strobe. It can be locked at the setting of between flood and spot as you want it, then it can't go out focus, and move every time its handled, I leave mine on SPOT, then at 200m it is easy to see, and it then opens up wider, BUT is great for me. I don't depress the switch all the way in; I just apply a little pressure to activate it, then after scanning release the switch.

With the normal light on spot, you can see 250m easily, with a photographic red filter you can scan and pick up eyes as far at 300m easily or more, and see to shoot a jackal at 180m, the light runs on 4 rechargeable penlights and this is far better than having to use a large red spotlight with car batteries etc.

This is how I operate when not using night vision, I don't use NV to much as your eyes get damaged. Next I want to put an infra red lens on this torch to try it out with my night vision, but that is for another day!

METHOD OF CALLING

I hold it in my hand and scan with the M14 torch with a red filter, anything as far as 350m I will see its eyes easily, I then watch it come closer, when it gets to 100m I then switch to the big chair mounted spotlight and shoot, or hold it against the rifle and shoot with the M14, OR mount the M14 under my barrel with the mounts and shoot. If I apply pressure on the switch it dims the light if I want a dimmer also, great technology.

This torch is small and deadly, I don't need huge car batteries under my chair, I scan with this M14 and shoot – BUT if needed if a jackal is far away, I switch to the big spot to shoot.

Amazing stuff, here is how I made my lens cover, so the light is thrown forward and not all over the bakkie when scanning. It is vital you make an exhaust pipe for the M14. Simple but effective this is.



Used a tablet plastic bottle, and fitted lens in the top and screwed the top back on and cut the back off, simple.
