

TRAIL CAMERA TRIPOD

Here is a simple thing I do as a tip for the guys using trail cameras, instead of having to look for a tree or post every time, I simply bolt a camera on a 3 legged steel tripod with a plate on top. Simple to make and its very stable, it stands 70cm high, a perfect height. Just weld 3 steel bars with a plate.

As a rule of thumb for best performance to get more pictures, I stand it 70cm high and the laser on the camera hits the ground at 10m, this is a perfect angle and anything moving up to 30m from this Bushnell will trigger the camera to fire, I place bait at 5m from the camera on the ground to make an animal stop, giving me more time to get pictures, and also face it angled to a road to allow an animal more time to pass giving the camera more time to fire, make sure the sun is behind the camera!
